Sasa Came to Church!

Remember Sasa? **The woman who stepped into the Muslim outreach center** because she saw the word "friendship" in the sign by the door, **is now attending church!** It's as hard for a Muslim to walk into a church building as it would be for us to take a trip down Niagara Falls in a barrel – maybe harder, because they are taught by their teachers (imams) that great curses come upon them if they walk into a church. *We are so thankful for your prayers for Sasa, and we're excited to see her taking steps toward faith in Christ.*



Street Evangelism

- A Muslim man, when I offered him a tract, ran away shouting, "You are trying to send me to hell." He is only repeating what he was taught at the mosque.

- A group of elderly women turn away shaking in fear when they recognize that the pamphlet I am holding talks about God and faith and hope. Many people here believe that faith is a forbidden subject, and anyone who talks about God is trying to trick them into joining a destructive cult.

- But some dare to take a tract, and read each page slowly and thoughtfully, glancing at me occasionally. Very few will talk, but recently I met someone who had never heard of Jesus.

We are planting seeds, and praying for a harvest here. Thank you for praying with us.



Three new people came to the Muslim outreach center. One man exclaimed to another, "You will not find hospitality like this among the Muslims." This is high praise, and it's gratifying to know that the unbelievers are astounded by the love of Christ.
